

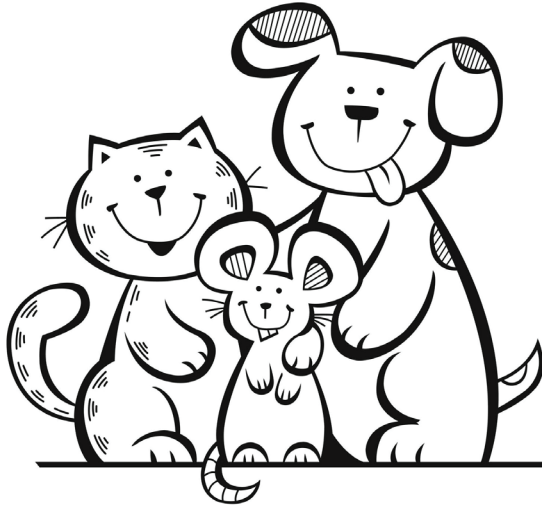
Healthy Nursery Policy

We cannot accept children who have the following symptoms:

- Coughing, sneezing, runny nose (unless slight and clear)
- Fever of 100 degrees or higher within the last 24 hours.
- Questionable rash or skin infection.
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea

Please do not bring sick children to the nursery.

A doctor's note will clear your child if he/she has symptoms but is non-contagious.

Our Primary Purpose:

Our primary purpose is to assist parents in the Christian nurture of their children and to encourage and equip our church family to fulfill this covenant responsibility. 1. Label all belongings: bags, bottles, cups, blankets, pacifiers (anything you want back).
2. Upon arrival, fill out the sign-in sheet and take a pager. Also, write your child's name on one of the name tag stickers provided and place it on your child's back.
3. If your child cries, we will do our best to comfort him/her. If, however, he/she is inconsolable for more than 10-15 minutes, we will page you.
